



## COVID19 CONTINUANCE PLAN BEGINNING JULY 5, 2020

### Sunday Worship

#### **General assembly protocol:**

- Enter the church through the main side door off the parking lot only. All other doors will be locked.
- No physical contact in greeting should be made with parishioners outside of your immediate family. No shaking of hands, no hugging.
- No coffee/cookie fellowship will be observed.
- The nursery will be closed. Children will need to remain with their parents.
- Face masks/coverings are recommended if you can wear one without physical/medical stress. We will have a limited supply of donated hand-made cloth masks available if you need one.
- Restrooms will be open, and we ask for you to sanitize the contact surfaces of the room on your way out after use. Supplies will be located just inside each restroom door. We will be using a spray solution that does not need wiped off or rinsed after application – simply spray the surfaces you had contact with and exit the room. This includes the doorknobs.

#### **Sanctuary protocol:**

- Enter the sanctuary through the rear door as we do for service/weddings/funerals.
- Church bulletins and offering envelopes will be placed on the table directly inside the sanctuary. Greeters will not hand out bulletins, nor will envelopes be found in the chair backs. Please pick them up as you enter.
- The offering basket will also be placed on the table by the church bulletins. Ushers will not distribute the baskets throughout the rows of seating during service. You may drop your offering in the basket on your way in to service, or on your way out after service.
- Proceed down the center aisle to the front of the sanctuary, fill the sanctuary from the front to back.
- Families are strongly encouraged to sit together beginning at the outside end of the row of seating. Maintain at least three empty seats between families sharing one row.
- Every other row of seats has been removed to maintain physical distance from anyone outside of one's household.
- Observe one-way traffic into the sanctuary as well as out of the sanctuary at the end of the service. We will exit one row at a time beginning at the back of the church.
- Seating will be sanitized following church gatherings.

### During the week

- No large gatherings in the sanctuary/fellowship hall.
- Small groups may meet in the kitchen only until further notice.
- Each group must sanitize following their meeting. Supplies will be provided.
